



School Uniform Policy

Principles

Our school uniform is important to us. It is one way in which we identify ourselves as a school family and it promotes a strong, cohesive school identity which supports high standards and expectations in all areas of school life. It promotes harmony between different groups represented in the school, and it enhances security, assisting the school to identify individual pupils in order to maintain good order and spot intruders more easily. **Smartness and high standards of appearance are expected at all times.**

We believe that school uniform is important because:

It contributes to a sense of belonging and fosters the feeling of pride in the school; it takes away the need for children to decide what to wear on a daily basis; Children need not be worried about issues of fashion or competitive dressing. It promotes equality of opportunity.

Aims

Through this policy we aim to ensure that within our school we promote an atmosphere which encourages effort, enjoyment and a celebration of the achievements of all our pupils. The school's concern for these high standards is also reflected in the pride we take in our school uniform and the feeling of belonging it creates.

The Governing board at the Jessop Stockwell Federation will respect variations to our school uniform if they are directly related to established religious or cultural traditions. However, any variation will be dealt with on an individual basis and judgments will remain at the discretion of the Executive Headteacher and the Governing Body.

In order to maintain a strong sense of identity and belonging within our school, we require all pupils to wear school uniform.

- Navy shorts and white t-shirt.
- Navy jogging bottoms are allowed for outdoor P.E.
- Black Trainers for outdoor P.E. (indoor P.E. can be done in bare feet)
- P.E. kit should be brought to school to be changed into (it must not be worn to school)
- House shirts (Red, Yellow, Green, Blue) are also allowed

All jewellery should be removed for P.E. or taped.

It is encouraged that pupils do not wear jewellery to school, especially as individuals become very upset if a treasured piece of jewellery goes missing. Should a pupil have pierced ears, plain studs should only be worn and in order to comply with health and safety regulations, must be covered with a plaster during all P.E. activities. The school will be unable to take any responsibility for any jewellery that is lost.
