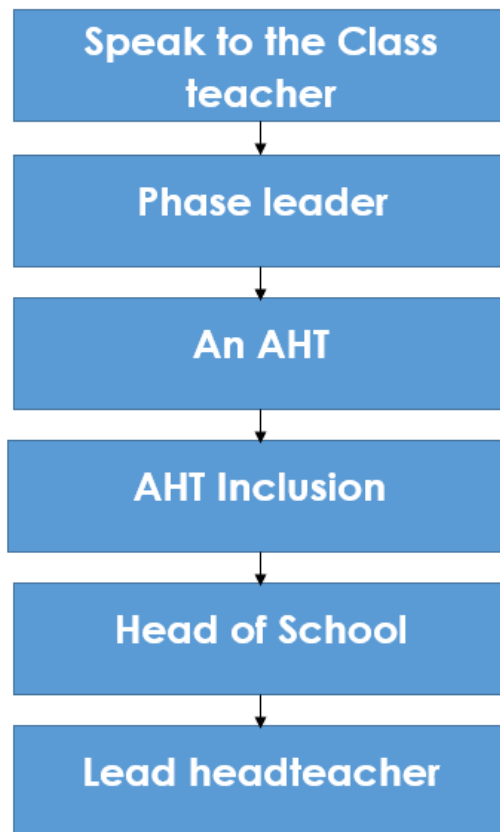
Parent Forum

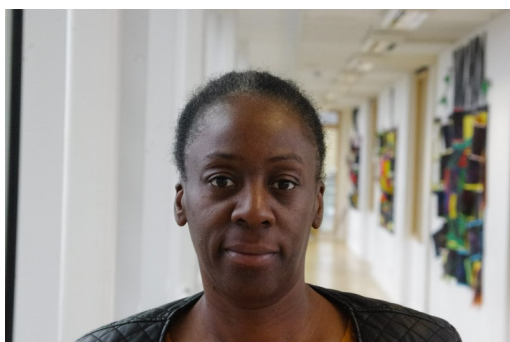
