LOCKDOWN PROTOCOL & FIRE EVACUATION

Intruder Attack Protocol - Overview:

A lockdown may be activated in response to situations including:

An incident or civil disturbance in the local community which poses a risk to the school:

An intruder on the site with the potential to pose a risk to the school;

Local risk of air pollution, such as a smoke plume or gas cloud;

A major fire in the vicinity of the school:

A dangerous dog or other animal roaming loose;

- If you hear a tannoy announcement: "Traffic Lights! Traffic Lights! Traffic Lights!"
- All staff, visitors and pupils are to lock themselves inside the nearest room and remain there until given the all clear.
- Staff visitors and pupils are to remain at floor level in silence as far away as possible from windows and doors.
- When you hear a tannoy announcement of: "Traffic Lights Terminated". It means it is safe to resume normal operations
- Partial Lockdown Alert to staff: If you hear a tannoy announcement: "Amber Light! Amber Light! Amber Light!"
- All staff and pupils remain in the building and external doors and windows locked
- Free movement may be permitted within the building dependent upon circumstances.
- When you hear a tannoy announcement of: "Amber Lights Terminated". It means it is safe to resume normal operations

Fire Evacuation procedures:

• If the fire alarm point is activated then:

Children's Centre: If you are inside: Staff, visitors and pupils evacuate to the Junction of Burgoyne Road and Combermere Road. If you are outside: Staff, visitors and pupils evacuate to Green Zone assembly point (adjacent to the trees)

• School: All pupils, staff visitors, evacuate to the Green Zone and await further instructions.
