Drop off and collection

We have made every effort to minimise the number of people and congestion around the school site during drop off and collection times. As such we ask that you follow the entry / exit points and timings set out for classes and year groups.

We ask that you do not linger during drop off or collection and maintain social distancing guidelines with regards to other families. We also ask that, where possible, drop offs and collections are made by 1 family member.

While we appreciate it may be difficult to do so, we ask that parents "Drop and Go", continuing to move towards the exit at all times . This is to reduce congestion and allow for a smooth running of collections and drop offs.

Extended Day Childcare

Resumption:

Extended day provision will resume at the start of term to coincide with the children returning to school.

Logistics:

Pupils that attend Breakfast and After school clubs will be grouped with their year group peers and based in an appropriate area, where timetabled services and activities will be provided for them by school staff.

Timings:

Breakfast club will open at 8:00am. There will be no admission after 8:30am. Breakfast club pupils will be taken straight to class by members of staff when the school day begins. Children attending can be dropped at the main office where they will be met by a member of the team.

After school club will be accessible from 3:15pm to coincide with the staggered end times. The session will end at 17:45. All children will need to be collected by then as usual. Parents are to collect pupils from the main office. Children collected early will be escorted to meet their parents at the main office. There will no longer be a 4:30pm dismissal.

Activities:

Activities will now be combined with childcare provision. A range of activities will be available for pupils including Drama, Film, Team games, Craft, Sewing, Multi sports and much more. These activities will be rotated amongst age appropriate groups.

Changes to fees:

To ensure that we are able to sustain the provision, we have taken the decision to increase the cost of Breakfast and After school club by 50 pence respectively. Childcare costs will remain aligned across the federation schools. The daily cost of a morning childcare place (Breakfast club) will increase from £2:00 to £2:50 per day this academic year.

Places for after school childcare will be set at a flat rate of £7:50 per day.

We are aware that current times have presented some families with challenges around finance and employment. Where possible we will continue to preserve subsidised places for vulnerable individuals on a case by case basis.

How to book:

Breakfast and After school club will be available to book on as payment items on Tucasi from Thursday 3rd September. If you experience any difficulty whilst trying to book a place, please contact the school office for advice and support. If you have any further queries about arrangements for extended day, please do not hesitate to contact the school via telephone or email. We will respond to you as soon as we can, providing further assistance if needed.

Frequently Asked Questions

<u>Siblings:</u>

Question: What do I do if I have more than 1 child and they have different start / end times?

Answer: Siblings can be dropped off and collected at their earliest start and end time.

Example: sibling 1 is in1B, sibling 2 is in 5C sibling 3 is 6A; all children will start at 8:45 and sibling 1 and sibling 2 will enter with their peers in the same year group (in this instance sibling 1 will join 1A for the start of the day and sibling 2 will join 5A). They will then join their class for the start of the first teaching session.

Siblings:

Question: What do I do if I have more than 1 child and they have different drop off locations?

Answer: Drop off and collect all children through entry point of youngest sibling. Staff members will be on hand to collect and then hand back your other children at the start / end of day

Example: sibling 1 in Reception,. Sibling 2 in Year 2 Sibling 3 in yr 4. All enter through Burgoyne road entrance, Drop off / collect sibling 1 at Reception classroom red zone and drop / collect sibling 2 and 3 with designated adult in Red zone. Exit through car park.

Wrap around

Question: Will there still be breakfast and after school provision?

Answer: Yes, please refer to extended day information on within this newsletter and letter sent.

Question: Will there still be breakfast and after school provision on Fridays?

Answer: There will still be Breakfast provision however there will be no after school provision on Fridays. This is due to the school closing by 13:00 on Fridays

Question: Will year groups mix?

Answer: No, all year group will have their own breakfast and afterschool groups

<u>Fridays:</u>

Question: Why is the school closing early on a Friday?

Answer: This will be time for cleaning and Preparation for the following week. The staggered end of day will continue however all children will be off site by 13:00.

<u>Covid:</u>

Question: Can my child wear a mask in school?

Answer: No, children can wear masks to school but need to remove them and store them safely in a sealable bag while at school

Covid:

Question: What measures are in place to keep my child safe?

Answer: Multiple measures are in place including year group bubbles, regular hand washing and sanitization of all areas of the school. For full information refer to Risk assessment shared.
