

Not only that but we all had great fun doing so!










6C Class assembly.

Jeans for Genes does for these children."



Starting secondary school in Lambeth

Information for parents/carers of children born between 01/09/09 and 31/09/10, or taught as a year 6 child during the 2020/21 academic year, who will be transferring from primary to secondary school in September 2021



Lambeth

A quick reminder of the key messages:

Application online opened from first of September 2020

The deadline is October 31st 2020

All applications must include proof of your address and proof that your child lives at that address.

All applications must include proof of your child's date of birth

You can choose 6 schools in order of preference on the Common Application Form

Remember to check if you also need to fill out a supplementary information form.

Some schools require your child to sit a test.


Most importantly attend virtually or in person open days or evenings. Take your child along!
