

Drop Off And Collection




Dear Parents and Carers,

As I am sure you can all appreciate we have been working hard behind the scenes to establish a more comprehensive online learning offer so that the children can

continue to make fantastic progress should the need arise that we have to close a bubble or move into another lockdown.

Along with this we have sent home devices with identified children to support with this.



Tasks will be set that are not worksheet heavy. Children will be asked to complete tasks and parents can upload photos.

All tasks set will have a simple self assessment for children to fill in. E.G:

•"Did you like this task?" :-) :-l :-(

• "Was this task difficult?" :-) :- !- :- (

Additionally the use of links to websites will also be used.

Sessions will comprise of a video input followed by a set activity

Parents can upload work completed to google classroom or directly to "Evidence Me"

We are pleased to let you know that Liz Atkinson will be open from January, the building work is finally complete and we cannot wait for you to see our lovely new garden! Our sessions across all of our children's centres will start back the <u>week commencing the 11th January 2021.</u>

To keep you, your family and our staff safe we have had to make changes to how our services are delivered. Things may look and feel different to how they were before;

What has changed....

- You will be asked to wash your hands (for at least 20 seconds) or use hand sanitiser on arrival.
- All of our group/face to face sessions <u>are now bookable</u>. If you haven't booked in advance and your name is not on the list, you will not be able to attend
- Our sessions have been reduced to an hour, so staff have time to clean and sterilise equipment used.
- . A very limited amount of parents and children will be able to attend. If a session is fully booked, you will be prioritised for the session the week after.
- Only 1 adult from each family is able to come along to a session.
- Windows and garden doors will be open within the centres to keep the rooms well ventilated.
- At stay and play we will encourage use of the garden space as much as possible, with minimal set up of play opportunities indoors so please dress for the weather.
- All adults need to observe social distancing rules and keep 2 metres apart.
- The entrance in to the centres may have changed, this will be clearly labelled.
- . Buggies must be left in the buggy park and not brought in to the centre.
- . If you put your name down to attend a course, you will be contacted to let you know you have a been given a place, spaces will be limited.

What is on....

Monthly Home Learning Resource Pack Collection – contact the centre you would like to collect from by telephone/text message and add your details to the monthly collection list. You will receive a message on collection day each month as a reminder you of the time to collect.

Story & Song Time - contact one of our centres by telephone/text message to add your mobile number to the list to receive weekly videos via WhatsApp.

Small Group Play – a small group play session for parents with children 1 – 4years.

Chat & Play - one to one appointments with a Better Start Worker/ Spanish & Portuguese Worker for support, a chat and a play opportunity.

Sensory Group - an invite only session for parents of young children with complex needs.

Baby Bounce & Rhyme - a small group rhyme session for parents with babies up to a year old.

Courses - please telephone/send a text message to the individual centre to put your name down.

Parenting Course – please sign up for parenting courses at www.lambeth.gov.uk/parenting, If you are interested in attending one of the courses taking place at our centres, please specify the course and venue at the time of signing up online.

Booking for Courses;

Please call the individual children's centre where the course is taking place, to register your interest. This does not mean you will be guaranteed a place; we will contact you if you are offered a place on the course. If you require a crèche place, it is important you let us know at the time of registering your interest, again this will not be guaranteed. Our crèche places will be very limited, at times, we may be able to offer you a place on a course but not a crèche place, so you would need to find your own childcare if you would like to attend.

Please do not attend any sessions if you, your children or anyone in your household is self-isolating, in quarantine, have any symptoms of coronavirus or generally feel unwell.

It is also very important that you do not come to the children's centre if you or anyone in your household are awaiting the results of a test for coronavirus.
