



EYFS Expectations

Tasks will be set that are not worksheet heavy. Children will be asked to complete tasks and parents can upload photos.

All tasks set will have a simple self assessment for children to fill in. E.G:

- “Did you like this task?” :-) :-| :-(
- “Was this task difficult?” :-) :-| :-(

Additionally the use of links to websites will also be used.

Sessions will comprise of a video input followed by a set activity

Parents can upload work completed to google classroom or directly to “Evidence Me”



Book Your Flu Vaccine!



If you can say yes to any of the following you can get a flu vaccine – just contact your GP

- All Over 65 Years Old
- All Children aged 2 or 3 years old on the 31st August 2020
- Age 6months - 65years in an at-risk group
- A carer
- A household member of a COVID-19 shielded patient
- A member of health and social care staff
- Pregnant
- A care home resident

*In late November we are expecting that all over 50 year olds will also become eligible and able to get a free flu vaccine.

Please note all primary school children and all year 7 children will be receiving the Flu vaccine through their school.

What Happens Next?

Your GP will contact you at the right time by text to invite you for a vaccine. They may book for you to have the vaccine at a site outside of the practice, but you can be reassured that these sites are still run by your GP practice
