

When collecting the flowing changes will be in place:

Please collect children form their year group designated areas:

Nursery, Reception, year 5 and Year 6 à Green Zone.

Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, and Year 4 à Red Zone.

If collecting **ANY** sibling from Green Zone please enter through **Burgoyne Road and collect from Green zone first**. If you then need to collect another sibling from the Red Zone go through sliding doors by main office and collect the next Sibling from Red Zone and leave through exit onto **Stockwell road**.

All siblings will be brought down within their year groups in relation to their drop off time.

Eg: If 2C child dropped with sibling in A class at 8:55 then they will be with 2A children ready for collection at 15:25.

Thank you for your patience, flexibility and understanding during this transition period.

Children's Centre New Program

We are pleased to let you know that small group face to face sessions will be starting back at all three of our centres from **Monday 19th April 2021.** To keep you, your family and our staff safe we have had to make changes to how our services are delivered, things may look and feel different.

What has changed....

- You will need to wear a face covering when entering the building and moving round the centre, if you are attending a parent/child play session you
 can remove your mask once you are in the session, if you wish.
- You will be asked to wash your hands (for at least 20 seconds) or use hand sanitiser on arrival.
- All of our group/face to face sessions are now bookable. If you haven't booked in advance and your name is not on the list, you will not be able to attend
- . Some of our sessions have been reduced to an hour, so staff have time to clean and sterilise equipment used.
- A very limited amount of parents and children will be able to attend. If a session is fully booked, you will be prioritised for the session the week after.
- . Only 1 adult from each family is able to come along to a session.
- Windows and garden doors will be open within the centres to keep the rooms well ventilated.
- . We will encourage use of the garden space as much as possible, with minimal set up of play opportunities indoors please dress for the weather.
- · All adults need to observe social distancing rules and keep 2 metres apart.
- Buggies <u>must be left in the outside buggy park and not be left in the centre.</u>

What is on....

Monthly Home Learning Resource Pack Collection – contact the centre you would like to collect from by telephone/text message and add your details to the monthly collection list. You will receive a message on collection day each month as a reminder of the time to collect.

Story & Song Time - contact one of our centres by telephone/text message to add your mobile number to the list to receive weekly videos via WhatsApp.

Small Group Stay & Play - a small group play session for parents with children 1 - 4years.

Small Group Friday Family Fun - a gardening, wellbeing and play session for parents and children.

Chat & Play - one to one appointments with a Better Start Worker/ Spanish & Portuguese Worker for support, a chat and a play opportunity.

Small Group Baby Sensory Group – a small group play session for parents with babies up to a year old.

Small Group Baby Bounce & Rhyme – a small group rhyme session for parents with babies up to a year old.

Courses – please telephone/send a text message to the individual centre to put your name down.

Parenting Course – please sign up for parenting courses at www.lambeth.gov.uk/parenting, If you are interested in attending one of the courses taking place at our centres, please specify the course and venue at the time of signing up online.

Starting Solids Session – small group face to face advice workshop with an early year's nutritionist about starting/progressing your baby to solid foods.

Please call the individual children's centre where the course is taking place, to register your interest. This does not mean you will be guaranteed a place; we will contact you if you are offered a place on the course. If you require a crèche place, it is important you let us know at the time of registering your interest, again this will not be guaranteed. Our crèche places will be very limited, at times, we may be able to offer you a place on a course but not a crèche place, so you would need to find your own childcare if you would like to attend.


