# Extended Day Childcare

## Timings:

Breakfast club opens at 8:00am. There is no admission after 8:30am. Breakfast club pupils are taken straight to class by members of staff when the school day begins. Children attending can be dropped at the main office where they will be met by a member of the team.

After school club begins at 3:30pm. Currently, after school club runs until 4:30pm. We are keen to extend this back to 17:45 and will let you know as soon as this is possible. Parents are to collect pupils from the main office. Children collected early will be escorted to meet their parents at the main office.

## Fees:

The daily cost of a morning childcare place (Breakfast club) is £2.50 per day this academic year.

Places for after school childcare are at a flat rate of £3 per day while the provision is until 4:30.

We are aware that current times have presented some families with challenges around finance and employment. Where possible we will continue to preserve subsidised places for vulnerable individuals on a case by case basis.

## How to book:

Breakfast and After school club are available to book on as payment items on Tucasi. If you experience any difficulty whilst trying to book a place, please contact the school office for advice and support. If you have any further queries about arrangements for extended day, please do not hesitate to contact the school via telephone or email. We will respond to you as soon as we can, providing further assistance if needed.



## The First Days in Early Years

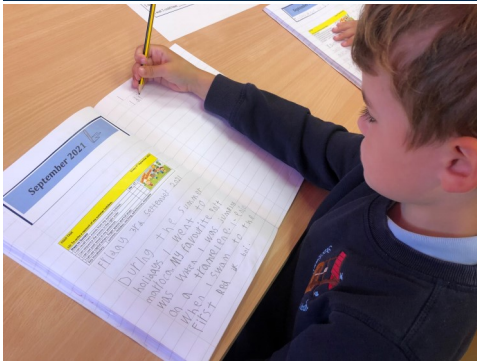

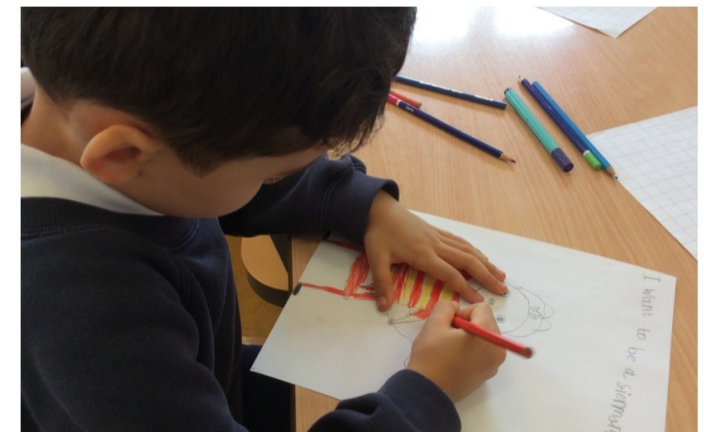


## Homework

This month we are thinking about Unicef Article 29: I have the right to an education which develops my personality, respect for others' rights and the environment.

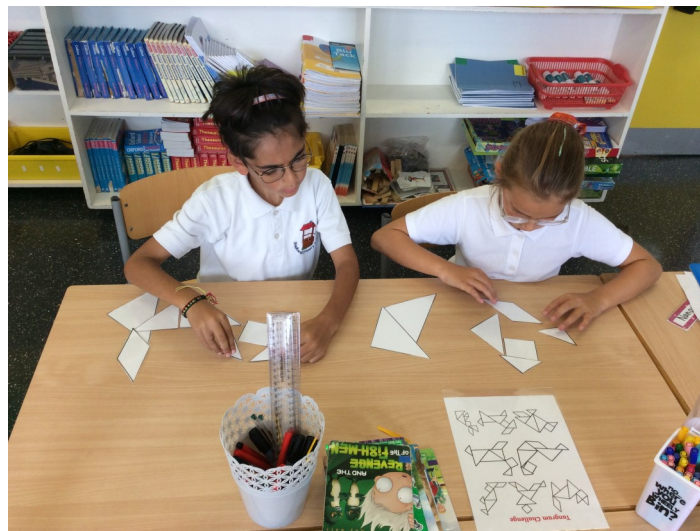


Year 4 are going to be learning about the Romans. This week they made the cover for the topic, inspired by Roman Soldiers' shields.
