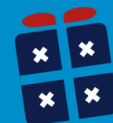

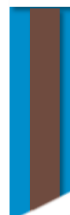

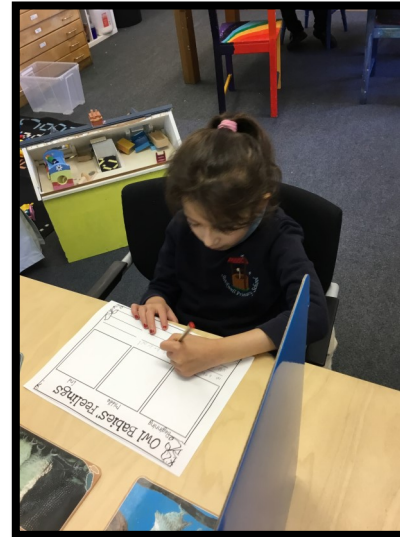

Reception

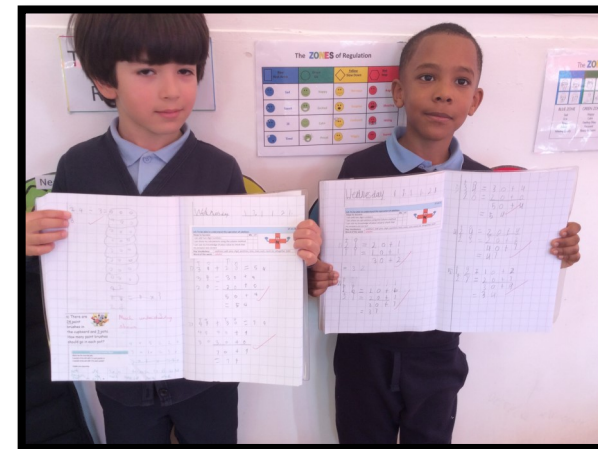

This week, Year 1 got to be involved in a fun space themed drama workshop with 'Perform'.

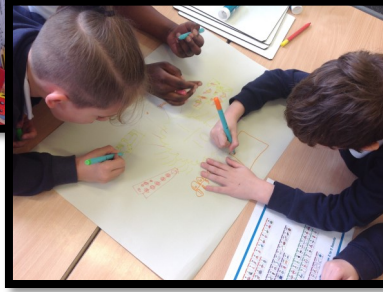
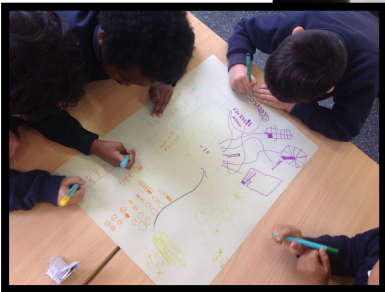


Year 2

Year 3:

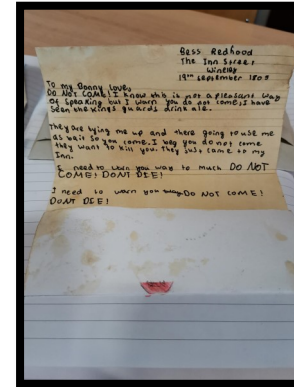
3C did a Maths

investigation to see how many different ways they could represent $\frac{1}{10}$, they used a variety of drawings, number lines and percentages to show this.



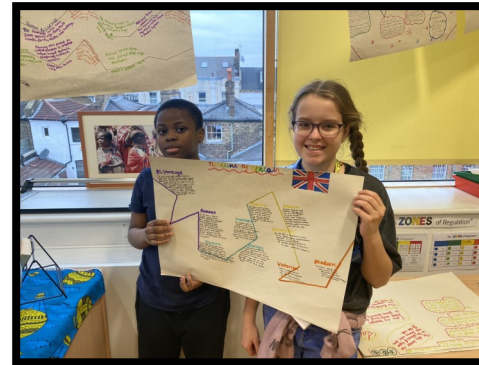
Year 4
