



Y1 have been busy learning about measurement. We started the week by using non-standard units to measure things around the classroom and moved on to using rulers to measure in centimetres (cm).





We have been creating collages of our inspirational people using the different collage techniques we have learnt in Art. Do you recognise the people that inspire us?








Year 3:


Year 5
