# KS1



## Year 1:

Year 1 have been busy this week making playground equipment using recyclable materials. We researched different types of equipment and designed and created our favourite one. The children also spent time getting ready for their Christmas play, *A Christmas Quarrel*. They enjoyed a brief dance party during their rehearsals to help them refocus.

Next term, the Year 1 topic will be Taking Flight. It will look at the History of Flight and significant individuals' impact on flight history. The children will find out about timelines of the developments of flight. They will also explore the continents of the world, using their knowledge to identify countries and plot the routes of significant flights in history.



## Year 2

What a lovely way to end the year! We had our much loved class party where Santa visited and gave us toys.

We also had Jumper Day where we all wore our beautiful jumpers.

Next term, our topic is London's Burning. We will be learning about the Great Fire of London, how it started and how it spread. The children will use maps to plot the spread of the fire across the city.



# LKS2



## Year 3:

Year 3 used clay to create their own Greek vases. They used the 'slip and score' technique to add handles and created Greek patterns using clay tools. Once the clay had dried, the children decorated their vases with an ancient Greek design.

Next term, Year 3 will be learning about WW2. They will find out how the war began and how it affected children in London. They will also consider how it changed our local area.

## Year 4

Year 4 have been learning about The Romans. They have debated whether Septimius Severus or Boudicca was the most effective leader. In DT, they designed and made Roman catapults to be used during Roman invasions.

Next term, Year 4 will be comparing Peru and England through the eyes of Paddington Bear.




# UKS2



## Year 5

Year 5 children enjoyed creating their cam toys during DT day last week. Based on our topic, Time Travellers, we created toys which can spin and vertically move!

Next term we are excited to start our topic. 'Windrush Journeys'. Children will be learning about Windrush and how it has shaped England. We will be looking at the topic through all of our subjects in the Spring term.



## Year 6

In Year 6, children completed their DT project and made vehicles powered by electricity. In their groups, the children assigned themselves roles: project managers, technical leads, construction engineers and automotive developers and we were very impressed by their teamwork and successful finished products!

After studying The Ancient Kingdom of Benin this term, in Spring, year 6 will journey across North America in their new topic: Route 66. Through the eyes of three travellers - Josh, Erin and Mia - they will explore geographical features and the California Gold Rush.
