We have been preparing the children for their end of Key Stage 2 assessments, commonly known as SATs.

In May, the children will complete tests in:

- Mathematical Reasoning
- Mental Arithmetic
- Reading and Comprehension
- Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

While this may seem like a while away, it is important that we prepare the children so that they can do their best and are ready for their assessments.

So that you are aware of the expectations, we are running a KS2 Assessment workshop on **Monday 28th February at 3:45pm** (this will be a re-run of the workshop that Ms. Kelleher and the Year 6 team ran this Monday, 21st Feb: there is no need to attend both). It is important that you understand what the children need to know, so we would urge you to attend so that you can support your children at home.

There will also be time at the end of the meeting for the team to answer any queries or concerns that you may have.
