

Dear Parents and Carers,



As you may be aware, World Book Day will be celebrated on the Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March. At Stockwell, we will be celebrating World Book Day and would love to make it a day to remember considering that it had such a positive impact on our children last year.

On Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March, we are encouraging the children to come to school dressed as their favourite book character. You do not need to buy a new costume. Often the best outfits are ones that are created with clothes and items you already have. Please do not feel the need to go to a lot of expense- if your child does not have a costume, they can always come in a colour and be a crayon from 'The Day the Crayons Quit'! Pinterest has lots of ideas.

All of the children will also be given a £1 voucher towards a book, or that they can take to a book store in exchange for a free book. We will be holding a reading drop-in from 8:50 – 9:15 to allow you to read in class with your children. In addition to this, our school librarians will be running a book swap after school. If you have any books at home that you've loved and want to swap with others, then please bring these in by Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March ready for the exchange. Children who bring in a book to swap will then receive a token that they can present at the book swap stall and take away a new book.

Please email the office/ or let your child's teacher know if you are available to read a book of your choice to the class. I will then begin to organise a timetable and let you know the time you can come in. If you are unable to come in on the 3rd March, we may be able to arrange it for another day that week.

Lastly, if you work in a profession that involves books, such as an editor or publisher etc we would love to invite you in to share with classes what you do. Please send the office an email and I will get back to you.
