RE: Industrial Action by the National Education Union – Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May

In April, the National Education Union (NEU), one of the trade unions representing the teaching profession, announced its intention to hold further strikes. These will take place on:

- Thursday, 27th April
- Tuesday, 2nd May

Following consultation with the teachers, I can confirm that the school will remain open for the following classes only

Thursday 28 th April	Tuesday 2 nd May
Preschool 3G Year 6 (both classes)	Preschool 3G Year 6 (both classes)

The school day will run as usual for these classes. There will be no changes.

Having reviewed our options based on the impact of staffing (that we are aware of at this point) and pupil safety, school will be closed for the following classes:

Nursery Reception Year 1 Year 2 3T, 3H Year 4 Year 5	Nursery Reception Year 1 Year 2 3T, 3H Year 4 Year 5

For children in **Year 4**, who are signed up to do **Cycle Training**, these **sessions will run as scheduled**. You will be contacted to let you know what time your child should arrive at school and when they should be collected.
