# Pre-School



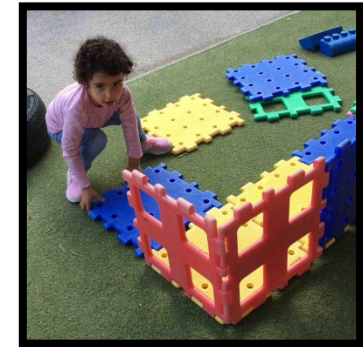

As we look back over this term, we note:

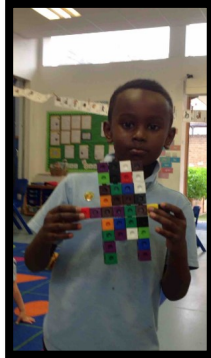

Lambeth EARLY YEARS SEN TEAM 



This year in the Inclusion Hub we have catered for a group of children with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) with a range of diagnosis. The children have been taught English, Maths, Music, PE and other curriculum areas. They attended daily phonics and 'attention bucket' sessions, which have supported them to develop their speech and language skills and their ability to read and write. Throughout the year, the children have accessed the outdoor learning, which includes our sensory garden, where we planted broad beans as part of the story book 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. The children also learnt through play with sand, soil, water and paint. The sensory room was another space treasured by our children, as it helps them to self-regulate.

We went to Blackheath Cricket tournament and played with 20 other schools.

We hit some sixes, fours and took some wickets winning 3 of our 6 games.

We enjoyed how our techniques have improved especially our bowling.

In English, the children identified features of a non-chronological report. They also researched information to produce a report of their own.

In Maths, the children have spent lessons consolidating all of their learning throughout KS1, in preparation for LKS2.

The children completed some wonderful field work observing and describing microhabitats, during their Science lessons. They also researched an animal of their choice and learnt about a habitat's suitability for its needs.

The children thoroughly enjoyed making templates for, then cutting and sewing, their puppets. We have very talented tailors and seamstresses in our midst!

Topic day was a huge success in Year 2! The children made every effort to display their fantastic learning through their posters and dressing up on the day. Well done Year 2!

# Year 3



In English, the children have been using the internet to research and make notes for a chosen rainforest animal. They then created their own non-chronological reports.

In Maths, the children have been exploring statistics. They have had a go at interpreting and creating pictograms and bar charts, using data collected first hand.

In Science, the children looked at the different bones and muscles in the human body.

In DT, the children made nachos using a range of kitchen equipment. They then tasted and evaluated them.

In Humanities, the children explored the Maya hierarchy in detail of job role and importance in the communities. They also took part in a quiz to test their Maya knowledge.

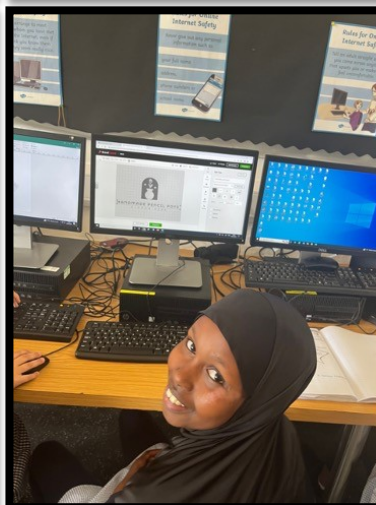
