Thank you for your support in ensuring that we have had a great start to the school year. As always, there are a few reminders that are of benefit to everyone so that things continue to run smoothly.

Soft Start

Please remember that children in Years 2-6 should be taken to the doors and then should make their own way through the building. **Please do not enter the building**, as this poses a safeguarding risk. We must be clear about who is in the building and where they are at all times. If you would like to speak to your child's class teacher, please do so at the end of the day, or make an appointment via the school office.

Water Bottles

Please ensure that your child has a water bottle at school each day, particularly in the warm weather. The children are encouraged to refill them throughout the day.

PE

The children have two PE sessions each week or, in the case of Years 4 and 6, one PE session and one Swimming session. They should be wearing full PE kit for their PE lessons. Going forward, the children are expected to come into school wearing school uniform as usual. **They will change for their PE lessons.** Children in Year 1 may come into school wearing their PE kits on a Tuesday morning and children in Year 3 may wear theirs into school on a Wednesday morning. They **must** bring their school uniforms in to change into after the lessons.
