Ref: Year 1 Trip to Horniman Museum

On Wednesday 13th of December, Year 1 will be going to the Horniman Museum to support their Topic curriculum. During the visit, the pupils will take part in a workshop to further develop their knowledge on Toys and Puppets Around the World.

We will leave school at 9.45am and return at approximately 2.30pm. We will use the TFL P4 bus to travel from Brixton Road Police Station to the Horniman Museum bus stop. Please ensure your child is wearing full school uniform and has appropriate clothing for the time of year.

At Stockwell we try to ensure as many educational trips as possible are undertaken with zero cost, however in this instance, due to the workshops and shows offered, **there is a cost of £4.10 per pupil**. Payment should be made to the school office.

Children require a packed lunch as this will be a full day visit. Packed lunches brought from home should contain a selection of healthy food and no glass bottles. If you require a packed lunch provided by the school, please inform the school by **the 6th of December 2023** using Scopay (Tucasi). The school will not provide a lunch unless it has been ordered and children who do not have a packed lunch will not be able to attend the trip.
