Dear Parents/Carers,

Parent/ Teacher consultations are a vitally important part of home school communications.

The appointments are about your child's academic progress; how well they are achieving; how much they are applying themselves and the challenges they are facing. Therefore, it is vitally important that we get the opportunity to have a discussion with you, so you that can encourage and provide the right targeted support at home.

We ensure that parents have the chance to look at the children's books, as these are available throughout the evening. This is also your opportunity to raise any concerns you may have about your child's academic achievement with their class teacher.

The Inclusion team are also available for meetings. If you would like to meet with Mrs Fraga, please let us know and this will be arranged.

All appointments are 10 minutes long and, following feedback from parents, will be in person, face-to-face in the school halls. However, we understand that some families prefer virtual meetings. **If you require a virtual meeting, please contact the school office, via email, and this will be arranged.**

We use an online booking system for consultation appointments with teachers using Tucasi-Scopay. This is the same system we use for payments, trips and clubs.

If you cannot locate your login details for Tucasi-Scopay, please contact the school and we will be able to email you your login details.

If you already use Tucasi for trips or club booking payments, you will already be set up and able to use the same login details.

Please ensure you take the time to login and set up as soon as possible.

The administrative team can support you with any teething problems you may face.

Hopefully, this will maximise opportunities for you to meet with us.

The meetings will take place between **3:50pm and 6:30pm on Tuesday 26th and Wednesday 27th March 2024.** The meetings will take place in the Blue, Red and Yellow Halls. EYFS meetings will take place in the EYFS classrooms.

Set up

- If you already use our online system for payments (school dinners, extended services), you are already set up to make an appointment
- If you have not used our system (Tucasi-Scopay), you need to use your login and register your account to make an appointment
- I recommend that you switch on your alerts within the system so you can receive a reminder of your appointment

Booking

- In your area, you will be able to see the available appointments for your child's/ren's teacher. If you have more than one child, stagger your appointments accordingly, to give you time to switch from one to the other
- Please **book on either the Tuesday OR the Wednesday**. You do not need to book on both days.
