Please do not attempt to join the trip unless your attendance has been confirmed by the office as this will invalidate our risk assessment.

Children will require a packed lunch as this will be a full day visit. Packed lunches brought from home should contain a selection of healthy food and drinks (no glass bottles). Please put this in a carrier bag with your child's name so that everything can be thrown away. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, please indicate whether you would like your child to receive a school packed lunch on the day of the trip. Please note that the school will not be able to provide a lunch unless it has been ordered and children who do not have a packed lunch will not be able to attend the trip.

Children are allowed to wear their own clothes, bring along a light rain proof jacket and wear sensible shoes as a lot of walking is involved. Children may also bring up to £15 in pocket money to spend on the day.
