Dear Parents and Carers,

## RE: Year 6 Residential Trip

Next year, we would like to take the current Y5 (soon to be Y6) children on their residential trip to PGL Marchants Hill. The visit is due to take place from **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November to Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November 2024**.

The children will be staying in purpose built lodges, with boys and girls sleeping separately. The supervising adults will be close by having a room within the lodge. All food will be provided for the duration of the visit and dietary requirements can be catered for. The children will take part a range of sessions everyday including activities such as: archery, abseiling, zip-wire and orienteering. We leave school on Tuesday at around 11am and will return on Friday at approximately 3.30pm. Further details about the week will be shared as we approach the departure date.

The full cost of the trip will be **£320**. A reduced price is offered to children who receive pupil premium and this will be charged at **£150** for the trip. If your child does not receive the automatic discount, we can apply for a bursary directly from PGL to families who are in receipt of the any of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit and an income of no more than £16,190.00)
- the guarantee element of State Pension Credit;
- an income related employment and support allowance

If you believe that any of the above applies to you, please make arrangements to talk with the school office so that we can apply for the bursary with PGL as soon as possible.

If you are NOT in receipt of any of the above benefits, but may have difficulty meeting the cost of the trip, please arrange to see myself (Ms. Kelleher) as we would not want any child to miss out on the chance to take part due to financial difficulties. Payment plans and installments can be set up to run from now until the end of their year 6 academic year (14 months) to help spread the cost.

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In order to reserve your child's place on this year's residential we now require a deposit of **£65** per full paying child and **£20** per Free School meal receiving child (this will reduce to **£20** if the bursary is successfully applied for following the presentation of relevant documents). This should be paid via Scopay by **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June**. You are welcome to pay in full at any time, or we are happy to accept instalments towards the final cost. The total cost will be due on **Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October**. Please note that if an insufficient number of parents make payments, the trip will not be able to go ahead. Please use Scopay (Tucasi) to give consent for your child to take part in the trip and make payments.

We know that families will have many questions regarding the trip. We would therefore like to invite you to a meeting on **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May in the Main Hall either at 9am OR at 3:45pm**. **There is no need to attend both meetings as the content will be the same.** At this time, you will have the opportunity to find out more about the site, accommodation, itinerary for the week, ask questions and discuss any concerns. In the meantime, please do not hesitate to approach me if you have any questions about the trip.
