Dear Parents and Carers,

Ref: Year 4 Residential Trip

On **Wednesday 20th to Friday 22nd November 2024**. Year 4 will be going to Ufton Court to support their Topic curriculum. During the visit, the pupils will be staying in a purpose built Manor House, with boys and girls sleeping separately. The supervising adults will be close by having a room within the house. All food will be provided for the duration of the visit and dietary requirements can be catered for. The children will take part in a range of sessions every day in line with their Autumn topic: The Romans. We leave school on Wednesday around 9am and will return on Friday at approximately 3.30pm. Further details about the week will be shared as we approach the departure date.

The price of the trip will be £230 with a further reduced price offered to families who are in receipt of the any of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit and an income of no more than £16,190.00)
- the guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- an income related employment and support allowance.

The school has applied for a Bursary will provide a 50% discount on the £202 cost for Ufton Court (price excludes the coach travel) while Ufton Court bursaries range from 5%-100%. These will be on a case by case basis but once the relevant documents are submitted we hope to be able to reduce the price further by a minimum of 5% and a maximum of 100% of the Ufton Court Educational Visit pricing.

If you believe that any of the above applies to you, please make arrangements to talk with the school office so that we can apply for the bursary with Ufton Court and a further reduced price can be offered once we have sent the relevant documents to Ufton Court.

If you are NOT in receipt of any of the above benefits, but may have difficulty meeting the cost of the trip, please arrange to see myself (Mr. Hirsch) as we would not want any child to miss out on the chance to take part due to financial difficulties.

In order to reserve your child's place on this year's residential we now require **a deposit of £30 per child** (this will reduce if the bursary is successfully applied for following the presentation of relevant documents). This should be paid via Weduc by **Monday 16th September 2024**. You are welcome to pay in full at any time, or we are happy to accept instalments towards the final cost. The total cost will be due on **Friday 25th October 2024**. Please note that if an insufficient number of parents make payments, the trip will not
