On Thursday 21st November, Class 2M will be going to the Florence Nightingale Museum to support their topic curriculum. During the visit, the pupils will learn about the life of Florence Nightingale and also visit the statue of Mary Seacole outside the hospital.

We will leave school at 9.30 and return at approximately 1.15pm. We will use the bus to travel from Brixton Station to St Thomas' Hospital. Please ensure your child is wearing full school uniform and has appropriate clothing for the time of year.

At Stockwell we try to ensure as many educational trips as possible are undertaken with zero cost. However in this instance, **there is a cost of £6.36 per pupil**. Payment should be made via Weduc.

If you would like to volunteer to accompany the class on this trip, please indicate this via Weduc. We will let you know whether you are able to come along on this occasion.

Children will require a packed lunch as this will be a full day visit. Packed lunches brought from home should contain a selection of healthy food and no glass bottles. If you require a packed lunch provided by the school, please inform the school by Monday 11th November using Weduc. The school will not provide a lunch unless it has been ordered and children who do not have a packed lunch will not be able to attend the trip.

Please use Weduc to give consent for your child to take part in the trip.
