Ref: Yr 3-6 Learn-to-Ride

We have been given the excellent opportunity to provide free Bikeability Training to our children in KS2. Please note: For children to participate in school Bikeability training, they must have basic riding skills (without stabilisers).

The learn-to-ride course is training for any child from any age group who can't currently ride a bike (without stabilisers). The dates for this will be **Learn-to-Ride training for up to 20 children from years 3 to 6: Mon 31 Mar & Tues 1 Apr 2025**. This safe, structured and standardised programme is designed to make your child a more competent cyclist and prepare them for cycling on road.

The Learn-to-Ride course is essentially just that: training for any child from any age group who can't currently ride a bike (without stabilisers).

We have been given the excellent opportunity to provide free Bikeability Training at Level 1 to our children in Year 3 & 4. The date for this will be **Level 1 Bikeability for up to 30 children from years 3 and/or 4: Wed 2 Apr & Thurs 3 Apr 2025**

This safe, structured and standardised programme is designed to make your child a more competent cyclist and prepare them for cycling on road.

In order to secure your child's place on this course, **please complete the attached form and give it to Mr Hirsch.**

All courses are first come first serve.

If your child has already completed a course in previous years, please do not sign them up again for the same course unless they are still not a confident cyclist at the level offered by the course.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SCHOOL CYCLE TRAINING (please read carefully)

1. I agree to my child taking part in cycle training.
2. Riders under the age of 16 will wear the supplied high-visibility waistcoat.
3. Balance bike and Learn to Ride course take place in the school playground or another off-road site and are designed to teach the basics of balancing and control.
4. Level 1 training takes place in the school playground or another off-road site for riders who can physically control the bicycle.
5. For Level 1&2 and L3 courses, whenever possible instructors will try to include riders who are not ready to continue onto the road, but the focus is on road training for riders who reach the required standard. They will be taken onto local roads for further training to develop skills and strategies for dealing with traffic.
6. Instructor's decision is final regarding whether children are ready to cycle on the road.
7. I agree that the instructor(s) can adjust my child's bicycle if necessary.
8. I agree that my child will conduct themselves in an appropriate manner and follow the directions of the instructor. I understand that the instructor may decline training for a child whose behaviour is disruptive or is considered to be putting themselves, other people or property at risk.
9. I am responsible for my child being suitably dressed for cycling.
10. If my child brings personal belongings to the course, they do so at their own risk.
11. I understand that Cycle Confident Ltd is not responsible for any injury or loss or damage to any person or property not caused by an instructor's negligence.
