Parks - Facilities & Services

Archbishop's Park

7:30am - 15 minutes before sunset - Carlisle Lane, SE1 7LE

A popular medium-sized open space in the heart of Waterloo. The park has a large children's playground and an extensive set of bookable sports facilities, including artificial grass sports pitches, cricket nets and tennis courts, along with changing rooms and toilets.

Hillside Gardens Park

7:30am - 15 minutes before sunset - Hillside Road, SW2 3HL

A medium-sized but popular park situated between Streatham Hill and Tulse Hill. It contains a children's playground and open games space, as well as a dog-free picnic area, a dog exercise area, and open lawns.

Knights Hill Wood Nature Reserve

7:30am - 15 minutes before sunset - Cedar Tree Grove, SE27 0SP

A small yet valuable pocket of woodland in Lambeth, and is managed for both its wildlife interest and as an educational resource for local schools and residents. It has a wide range of fungi and insects, including the larvae of Stag Beetles.

The Rookery, Streatham

7:30am until 30 minutes before dusk - Covington Way, SW16 3BX

An attractive formal garden located between Streatham, Norbury and West Norwood. The Rookery, a Grade 11 Listed Historic Garden, contains a cascade of ornamental ponds, planted herbaceous and wildflower beds, including and Old English Garden and a White Garden
