Ref: Year 3 Trip to Imperial War Museum

On **Friday 6th March**, Year 3 will be taking a trip to the Imperial War Museum to support their learning of World War 2. During the visit, children will explore a range of interactive exhibits and historical artefacts, helping them to develop a deeper understanding of life during the war, including evacuation, rationing and the experiences of children at the time. The visit will enrich their classroom learning and provide valuable first-hand experiences to support their current topic.
