Ref: Brockwell Park Trip

On Thursday 12th March, children in RB will be going to visit the walled garden in Brockwell Park to support their learning about plants. During the visit, the pupils will explore the plants and flowers and discuss similarities, differences and stages of growth. They will also spend some time in the play park as a reward for their hard work so far this academic year.

We plan to leave school at 10:00am and take the number 2 bus to the Tulse Hill entrance to the park. We will return the same way, arriving back at school at approximately 1:00pm.

As we intend to eat a picnic together in the park, children will require a packed lunch. Packed lunches brought from home should contain a selection of healthy food and no glass bottles. If you require a packed lunch provided by the school, please inform the school by Thursday 5th March using the BJS Federation Parent App (Weduc). The school will not provide a lunch unless it has been ordered and children who do not have a packed lunch will not be able to attend the trip.

Please ensure your child is wearing full school uniform and has appropriate clothing for the time of year. In the unlikely event heavy rainfall is forecasted, the trip will be cancelled. In this instance, a message will be sent to parents before the intended day.

There is no cost for this trip.

If you would like to volunteer to accompany the class on this trip, please indicate this via the BJS Federation Parent App (Weduc). We will let you know whether you are able to come along on this occasion. Parents who may be required to accompany their child will be contacted directly.
