Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: Year 6 Residential Trip

This year we will be taking the Year 6 children on their residential trip to PGL Marchants Hill. The visit will take place from **Monday 9th November to Friday 13th November**.

The children will be staying in purpose built lodges, with boys and girls sleeping separately. The supervising adults will be close by having a room within the lodge. All food will be provided for the duration of the visit and dietary requirements can be catered for. The children will take part a range of sessions everyday including activities such as: archery, abseiling, zip-wire and rock climbing.

We have organised some meetings to give you more information about the trip and explain the arrangements. These will take place on **Thursday 10th September at 9am and 3:45pm**. Both meetings will take place in the Main Hall.

PGL have offered us a discount and therefore, the cost of the 5-day trip and the coach to and from the centre will be **£190** per child. A reduced price of **£140** can be offered to families who are in receipt of the any of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit and an income of no more than £16,190.00)
- an income related employment and support allowance

If you believe that any of the above applies to you, please make arrangements to talk with the school office so that we can apply for the bursary as soon as possible.

If you are NOT in receipt of any of the above benefits, but may have difficulty meeting the cost of the trip, please be aware that payment plans can be arranged. We would ask that all parents who wish for their child to attend make a £10 deposit ASAP so that we can confirm our numbers with PGL. Again, arrangements can be made regarding payments as we'd really love to take all of the children on the trip for their final year of primary school!
