Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back!

I hope that you all had a wonderful, restful summer and that you enjoyed the holidays. I look forward to hearing all about the children's adventures and to getting to know all of our new starters.

School begins at **8:50am tomorrow, Wednesday 2nd September**, for **Years 1-6**. We are looking forward to welcoming you back to school then.

Children in EYFS (Pre-school, Nursery and Reception) will be taking part in Stay and Play Sessions, and will then start school as follows:

- Friday 4th September – Reception from Stockwell Nursery children's 1st day (half day)
- Monday 7th September – Continuing Nursery and Pre-School children return
- Tuesday 8th September – New to Stockwell Reception children's 1st day (half day)
- Wednesday 9th September – New to Stockwell Nursery/ Pre-school children's 1st day

Please refer to your individual letters for the date and time of your child's session and for your child's start date and time.

The gates will open at **8:50** each day for our soft start.

Children in Years 2-6 will be greeted by their teachers in the playgrounds on Wednesday 2nd and Thursday 3rd, September, so that they know how to make their way to the classrooms.

- Year 2 will meet their teachers in the Play Zone
- Years 3 and 4 will meet their teachers in the Games Zone
- Years 5 and 6 will meet their teachers in the Play Zone

From Friday, teachers will remain in the rooms, and children can make their way to classrooms as usual during the Soft Start.

Children in EYFS and Year 1 can be escorted to the classroom doors, in the Green Zone each day.

The school gates will close at 9am promptly. Please note, parents are not permitted to enter the school building during soft start. If you need to speak to your child's teacher, please make an appointment via the school office.

End of Day:

The school day ends at 3:30pm. As such, the gates will open at this time. At the end of the day, dismissal arrangements are as follows:

Communications:

We aim to limit our school communications to Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please keep an eye on your email inboxes and the BJS Federation App on these days for letters. Class teachers post regular updates on the BJS Federation App (Weduc), and this is where you can pay for clubs, book school dinners and give permission for trips and visits. It also has an up-to-date calendar, so please make sure that you have your login. If you are unsure, please come to the office, where we can assist you.

PE:

All children will take part in two PE lessons per week. Please ensure that your child has a full PE kit in school on the correct days:

- Blue or black tracksuit bottoms or plain white/ blue/ black shorts
- Plain T shirt
- Trainers (suitable for a range of sports activities. It is unsafe for children to wear their school shoes during PE lessons)

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Your child's PE days will be shared with you during your Meet the Teacher Session. Children in Year 4 will be swimming throughout the year. More information, such as kit requirements, days etc, will be shared with you in due course.
